

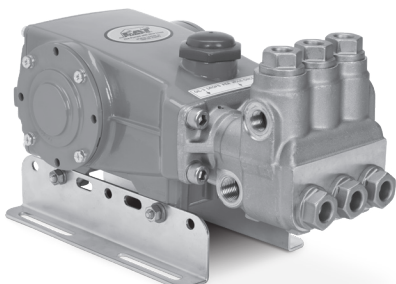

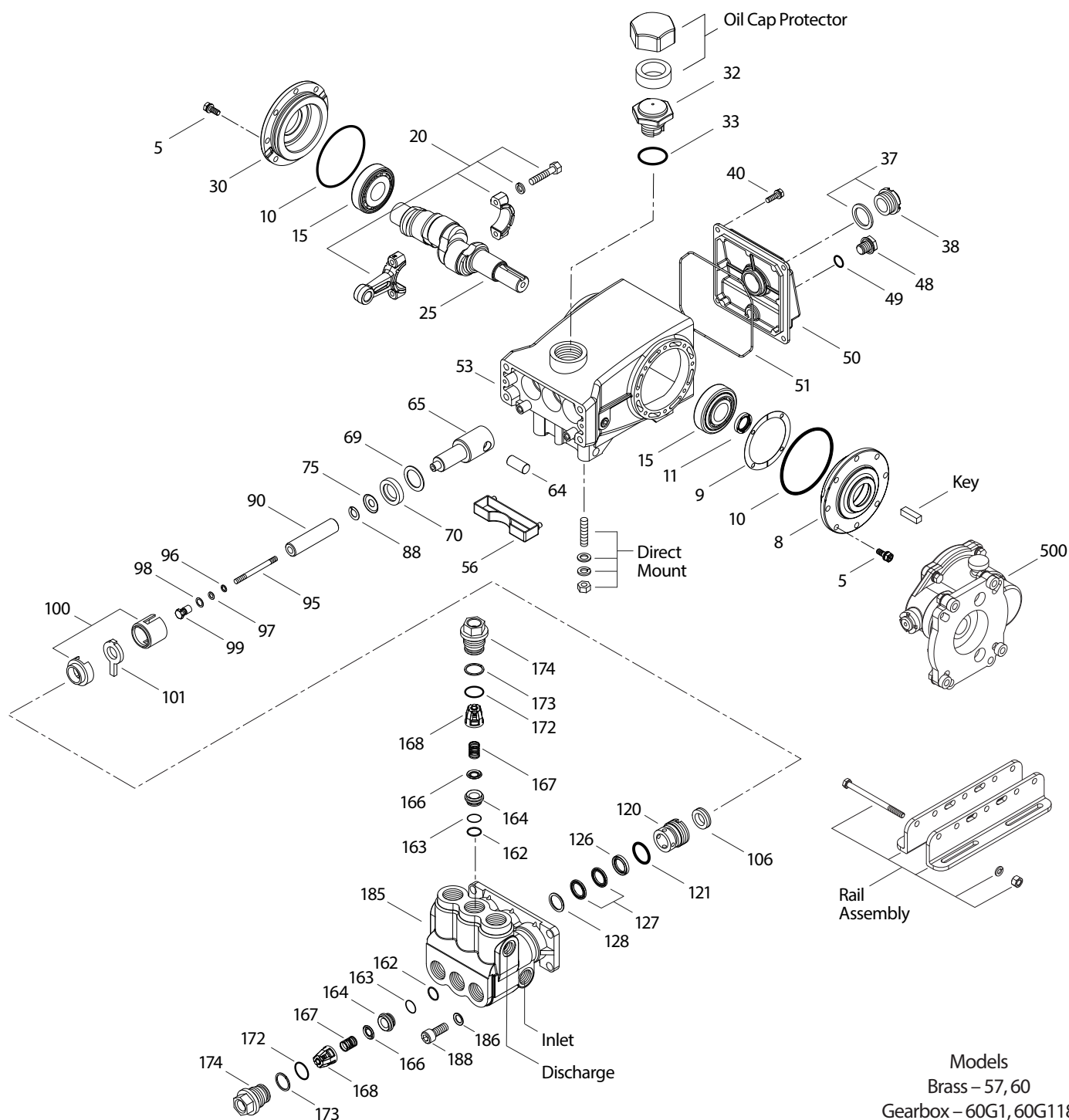

EXPLODED VIEW



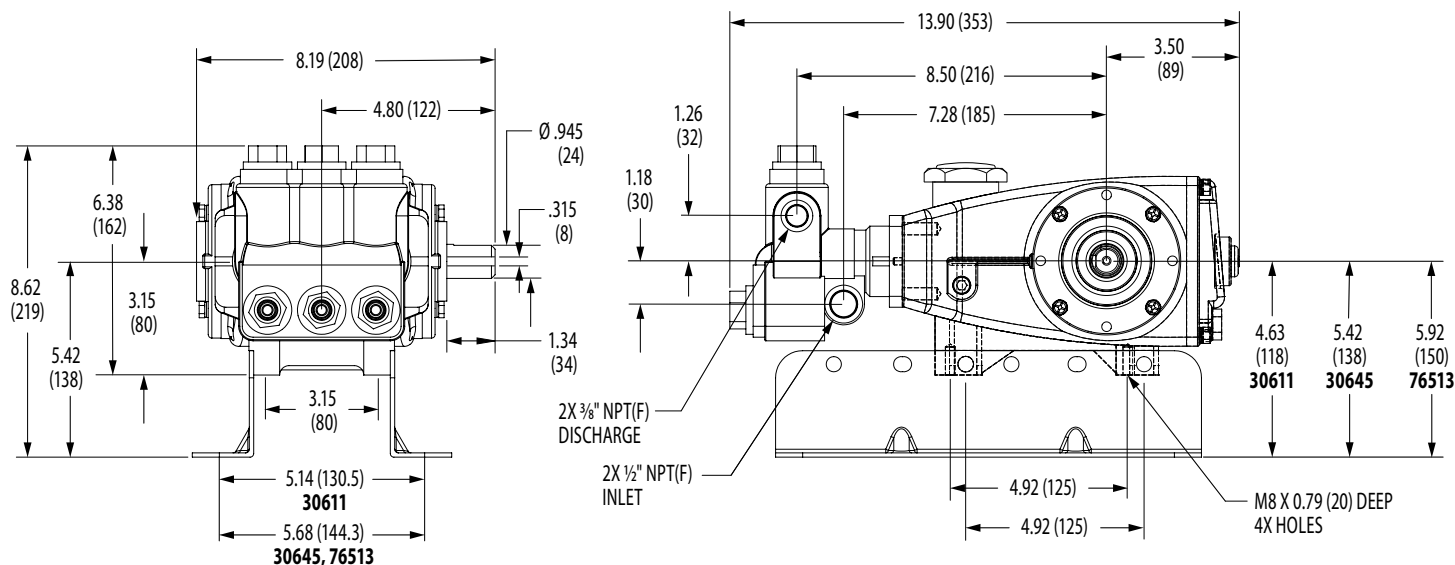
